2 Hotels

We have spoken several Amsterdam hotel managers about special arrangements. But we have noticed ourselves as seminar/conference participants the last few years in other countires, that the situation has changed . It is possible to make a 'seminar prices deal' but there are also rooms available for even lower prices, using general websites like www.booking.com, www.expedia.nl, www.hotels.com, et cetera.

The western part of Amsterdam being the venue we suggest to keep in mind:

- The venue can easily be reached by tram from the centre of Amsterdam (numbers 1 and 17), starting at Amsterdam Central Station. Both trams run through the centre of Amsterdam, so if you are staying in a hotel near the Central Station or in the centre, you can take one of these trams, every 10 minutes. It takes about a 30 minutes from the centre.
- But you can also take the train from Amsterdam Central Station to Station Amsterdam Lelylaan, and from there by tram (1 or 17) to the venue. This will also take about a 30 minutes.
- From hotels near Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, there are busses from the Airport to the venue, with a stop in front of The Meervaart. This will take about 45 minutes. But you can also take a shuttle bus from the hotel to Schiphol, and by train to Station Amsterdam Lelylaan (10 minutes) and by tram to the venue (5 minutes).

We will publish a few maps of Amsterdam on the seminar website, and information on trams, trains and busses (numbers, schedules). And of course you can send us an email if you have questions about possible hotels and 'how to get to the venue'.

4 From Schiphol Airport to...

If you are flying to Amsterdam Schiphol airport, it is easy to travel to...

Amsterdam centre:

There is a direct train from the airport to Amsterdam Central Station. From there you can take several trams to the center and to your hotel. A taxi is also possible, but this will be more expensive

Traintickets are available using tickets machines, at every station.

You need an electronic ticket ('public transport card') for trams, busses and metro trains., which you can buy at Amsterdam Central Station.

Venue, De Meervaart:

Every half hour there is a direct train from Schiphol Airport to Station Amsterdam Lelylaan (direction Amsterdam Central Station – takes 10 minutes). From there you have to take the tram to the venue (number 1 or 17). This will take about 20 minutes.

Hotels near the airport:

Most of the hotels have a shuttle bus.
